PAYMENT AGREEMENT

A payment plan of **\$371.25** per month for **99** months has been established to assist you in resolving your outstanding tax liability. Your first payment is due by **January 15, 2014** and on the same day each month thereafter. Accrued interest has been calculated into the monthly payment based on the total number of installments. Late or missed payments could void your payment plan resulting in other collection actions. Any State or Federal refunds that are intercepted and credited to your liability are not considered part of your monthly installment. You must still make your regularly scheduled payments.

We will send you a payment voucher and envelope each month. Failure to receive the voucher will not extend the due date; payments must still be made. Your payment plan is subject to periodic review and could be terminated or monthly payments increased if future liabilities develop. A lien and judgment may be filed with the appropriate circuit court to protect the State's interest and will be released once paid in full.

To ensure proper credit to your account, write your social security number on your check or money order and send it with the tear off portion below. Please allow sufficient mailing time to ensure your payment is received by your due date. **If you have arranged payment of your taxes using our direct debit repayment option, you are not required to send any additional payments at this time. If you elect to send an additional payment, you will be responsible for any overdraft charges that may result from your failure to have sufficient funds in your account at the time of the debit.** You may also pay through Official Payments Corp. by calling 1-800-2PAYTAX (800-272-9829) or on their website at www.officialpayments.com.
