This letter is to confirm our temporary agreement concerning your outstanding Business Tax Liability in the amount of **\$14,716.49** for the above referenced account.

Please be advised that monthly payments in the amount of **\$1,000.00** will be acceptable for liquidating this liability. The initial payment of **\$8,830.00** is to be remitted by GUARANTEED FUNDS by **April 28, 2014**, and the monthly payments are due on the **5th** of each month beginning **May 5, 2014** and ending on **November 5, 2014**.

Interest will continue to accrue on the outstanding tax balance.

All returns due to the Comptroller of Maryland must be filed and paid when due.  
STRICT ADHERENCE TO THIS SECTION OF THE AGREEMENT IS A MAJOR REQUIREMENT OF THIS PAYMENT PLAN.

Failure to adhere to the above agreement will result in **Seizure of your Liquor License** and full payment of the liability owed.

Any disbursements due to you from the State of Maryland will be applied to any liability owed to the Comptroller of Maryland. This action is taken under the State Finance and Procurement Article Section 7-222, of the Annotated Code of Maryland, and in no way affects this payment schedule.
