- Make sure we receive your monthly payments by the due date.
- File all future tax returns and make payments on time.

#### If This Payment Agreement Is Broken

- We may charge you additional penalty, interest and fees.
- We may record tax liens, garnish your wages and bank accounts, take and sell your property or refer your account to a collection agency.

#### Please Note

- The total payment agreement is for \$24,189.20. This amount includes tax, any penalty, fees and interest through the date of your final payment.
- If the legal interest rate changes, the final payment amount may change.
- All payments are applied to any penalty, any interest and then tax.
- This payment agreement does not guarantee a tax lien will not be recorded.
- If a tax lien is recorded, it will be withdrawn 30-60 days after you pay the balance due for all periods included in the payment agreement.
- We may take your state income tax refunds and other amounts the state owes you for payment toward the balance due.
