Dear Taxpayer:

Although you were late in your substantiation of your attempts to sell your real property I have enclosed two separate Installment Agreements Forms 433D as Collection Alternatives for you to review and choose. The first agreement calls for you to liquidate your Cash Value of Insurance Policies of \$37,000 then payments of \$500 per month will be due no later than the 25th day of the month. It normally takes about 45 days to secure the cash value and that is why the first payment \$37,000; will be due on May 25, 2012. The second agreement is for \$893 beginning on May 25, 2012 and continuing until all liability is paid.

I also reviewed your request for penalty abatement and I am recommending abatement of all failure to pay and deposit penalty for the first quarter of 2002 when your relatives became ill and moved in with you. I also am recommending abatement of all failure to pay and deposit penalties for the first quarter of 2009 when the construction on Hwy. 90 began. See the attached copies of Form 3870. I also enclosed Forms 12257 Waivers which I request you to sign, date, and return to me with the signed and dated Part 1 of the corresponding Form 433D and with the initial check required in the enclosed envelope.
